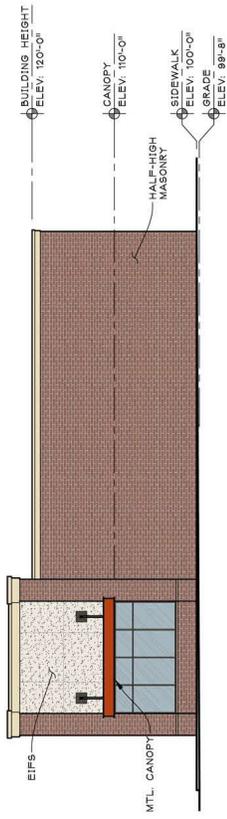




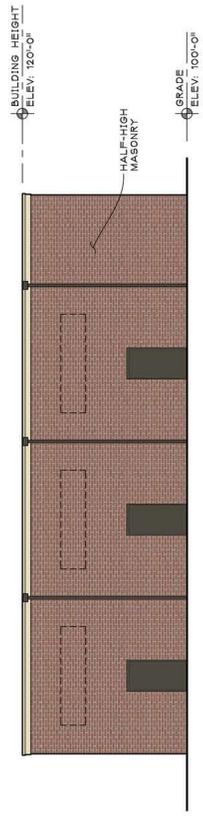
**KEY PLAN**

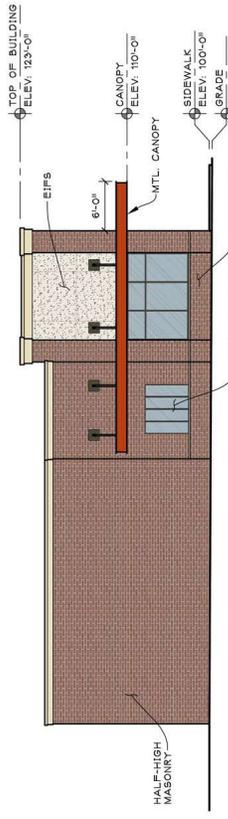
**FLOOR PLAN**

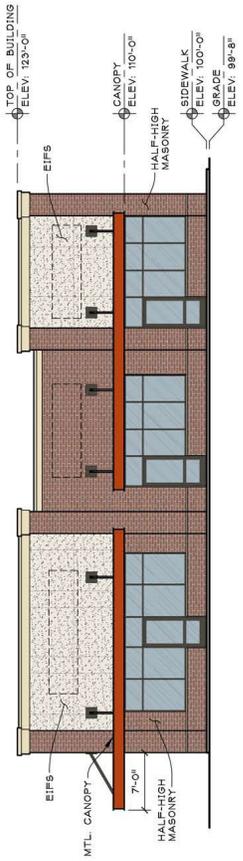

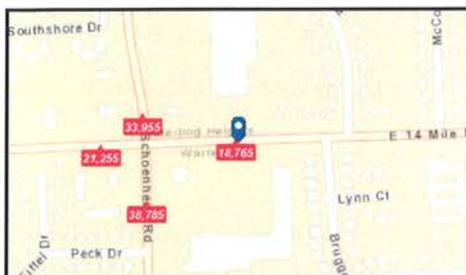
